Awards Ceremony: Thursday, August 4, 2011 | 8:00-8:30 p.m. | **Weber's Inn (3050 Jackson Ave.)**

Prizes will be awarded in six (6) categories (*the grade they are going into in the fall; with the exception of recently graduated 12th graders - they may still enter as 12th grade*):

Preschool, Grades K-2, Grades 3-5, Grades 6-8, Grades 9-12 & Adults.

Prizes:

Within each category there will be three winners: **1st Place, 1 Runner-up and 1 Honorable Mention.** Winners will receive gift certificates for *Target* in the amounts of **\$35.00, \$25.00 and \$15.00** respectively. Winners will also receive prize ribbons.

Prize ribbons will also be awarded in each category for the following:

Best Motorized project; Best Architectural/Engineering project; Coolest Robot; Best Vehicle; Most Creative; Most Sophisticated and, AADL Lego® Master Builder!

Rules:

1. Use your own Lego®, Duplo, Megablocks or other Lego® compatible plastic brick.
2. Entries must be your own creation, not a Lego® designed kit, project found online, in a magazine etc.
3. One entry per participant or team where applicable.
4. Your creation must fit within a space of 24 by 24 inches. Your completed project may be no taller than four feet tall.
5. Team projects will be placed in the category of the **oldest** participant in the team. Individual entries will not be permitted for team participants. Please note that while all members of a team will receive a prize ribbon (if applicable) a team will compete for a single prize.
6. Please provide a sign/label with your project with your name(s), grade and phone #. The sign must also explain the idea/inspiration for your creation to help the judges make their determinations.
7. Completed projects must be delivered to Weber's Inn @ 3050 Jackson Ave., Ann Arbor on **Thursday, August 4 between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.**
8. Judging will be conducted the evening of Thursday, August 4 at Weber's Inn by a team of adult Lego® enthusiasts. The doors will open at 6:00 p.m. to allow for the entries to be viewed by the public.
9. The Awards Ceremony will begin at 8:00 p.m on Thursday, August 4.
10. Completed entries **MUST** be taken home on the evening of Thursday, August, 4 after the ceremony ends.
