Rules & Guidelines

Deadline to Submit: Monday, July 30 by 9:00 p.m.

Awards Ceremony: Monday, August 6 | 7:00-8:30 p.m. | Downtown Library

Who: Prizes will be given out in five categories:

Grades K-2; Grades 3-5; Grades 6-8 and Grades 9-12.

Judging: Fred Gallagher, of www.megatokyo.com and Jerzy Drozd, of mlatcomics.com are our judges!

1. Each participant may enter up to two drawings.
2. Your entry must fit on a sheet of white 8.5 x 11 paper.
3. You may use any medium to create your work (e.g. pencil, pen, crayons, or an online drawing application).
4. There is no limit as to what or how you create something – you may want to create a story and tell it in comic strip format, copy your favorite manga character or create your own character
5. Entries must be labeled on the back with your name, grade, and phone #.
6. Entries may be delivered to any Information Desk at any Ann Arbor District Library location by 9:00 p.m., Monday, July 30th.
7. Entries must be dropped off in an envelope marked “Manga Drawing Contest.” Please print participant’s name, grade and phone number written on the outside of the envelope.
8. The Awards Ceremony will be on Monday, August 6 from 7:00-8:30 p.m. at the Downtown Library Youth Story Corner.
9. Completed artwork will be displayed in the Downtown Youth Department during the month of August. Artwork may be picked-up at the Youth desk at the Downtown Library during the first week of September

Prizes :

Within each grade category there will be three winners: **1st Place, 1 Runner-Up and 1 Honorable Mention.** Winners will receive gift certificates for **Wizzywig** in the amounts of **\$30.00, \$20.00 and \$10.00** respectively.

Prize ribbons will also be given out in each grade category for the following:

Best Comic Strip (a sequential story told in traditional box form), *Best Fan Art* (a copied image of a previously created character), *Best Original Character* (created by the artist – not a copy).

Every participant will receive a certificate for their participation.
