

THE AGATHA CHRISTIE PHENOMENON

Is it not perhaps more than a little odd that an English girl from Torquay, born Agatha Miller in 1890, who had no formal education to speak of would grow up to become the most famous murder mystery writer since Sir Arthur Conan Doyle?
