Director's Notes

August Wilson is an urban observer, a chronicler of black lives lived in run-down neighborhoods. Brought up in Pittsburgh, he inherits experiences and visions from those who were part of the great migration from the South to the North in the early decades of this century. In 1973 he embarked in a cycle of dramas set in each decade of that period. *FENCES* is the one set in the 1950's. In them, Wilson found his voice in the American Theatre. He began as a poet and succeeded as a playwright. Now 46, this self-educated high school dropout has won two Pulitzer Prizes and a Tony Award.

Wilson's compelling characters, rich dialogue and provocative themes make a major contribution to the contemporary American theatre. He gained national attention through his work with the Eugene O'Neill Theater Center in Connecticut, which is headed by director Lloyd Richards. What followed became a successful collaboration that lasts to this day—*MA RAINY'S BLACK BOTTOM*, *FENCES*, *JOE TURNER'S COME AND GONE* and most recently *TWO TRAINS RUNNING*.






